

Small Business Grants – Round 2 Opening 1 July 2020

17 June 2020

In May, the Queensland Government released the \$10k Small Business Adaptation Grants to support small businesses affected by Covid-19 shutdown restrictions to get back on their feet. The grants were in such high demand, that the \$100m in funding was exhausted within the first five days. The Government has now announced that on 1 July 2020 round 2 of the program will open.

The second round will be administered differently in that the funding will be divided equally between regional Queensland and South East Queensland businesses. SEQ is defined by these regions:

- Brisbane City Council
- City of Gold Coast
- Ipswich City Council
- Lockyer Valley Regional Council
- Logan City Council
- Moreton Bay Regional Council
- Noosa Shire Council
- Redlands City Council
- Scenic Rim Regional Council
- Somerset Regional Council
- Sunshine Coast Council
- Toowoomba Regional Council

Regional Queensland is defined as all other local government areas within Queensland.

Further key information

- Successful applicants from round 1 of the program cannot apply for further funding under round 2.
- Businesses who applied in the first round but have not heard back yet, or who were unsuccessful, can reapply in this round.
- The available grant amount is a minimum of \$2,000 and up to maximum of \$10,000 per eligible small or micro business.
- All applications must be completed online, from 1 July 2020 when the grants open.

The QLD Gov has released an online eligibility checker to assist you in working out if your business can apply. [Eligibility Checker](#).

Once you have confirmed you are eligible to apply, we recommend you start preparing your supporting documentation so that you are ready to submit the application online as soon as it opens on **1 July 2020**. It is anticipated that the funding will be exhausted quickly again, as it is a first in, first assessed process.
